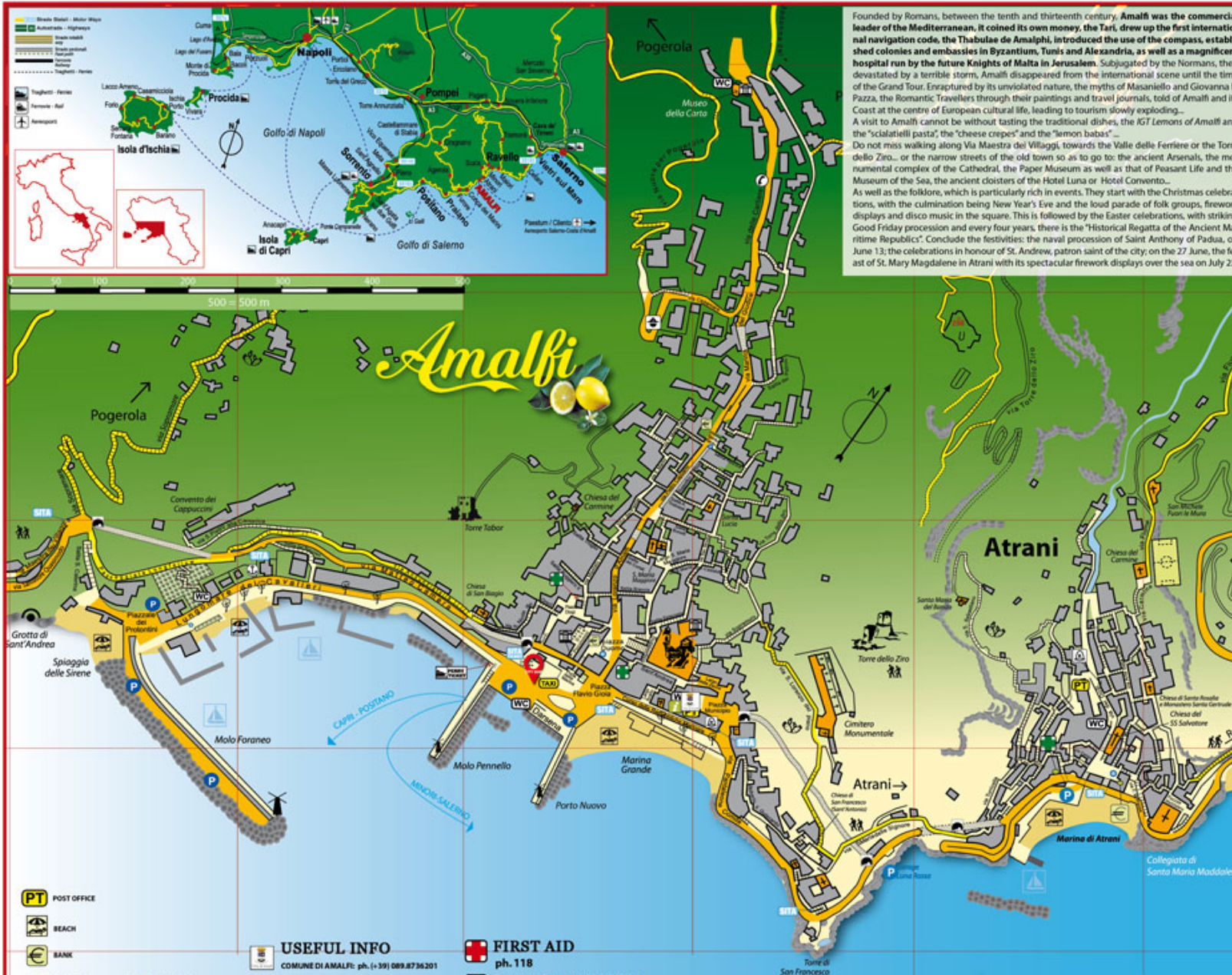
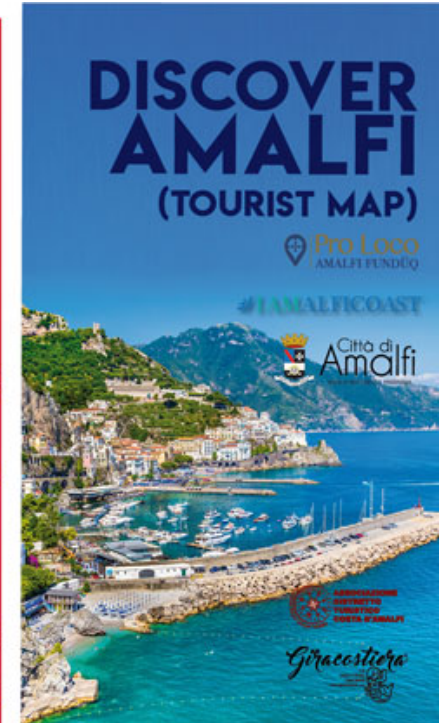


Discovery Amalfi 2019

Founded by Romans, between the tenth and thirteenth century, Amalfi was the commercial leader of the Mediterranean, it coined its own money, the Tari, drew up the first international navigation code, the Tabulae de Amalphi, introduced the use of the compass, established colonies and embassies in Byzantium, Tunis and Alexandria, as well as a magnificent hospital run by the future Knights of Malta in Jerusalem. Subjugated by the Normans, then devastated by a terrible storm, Amalfi disappeared from the international scene until the time of the Grand Tour. Enraptured by its unspoiled nature, the myths of Masaniello and Giovanna la Pazza, the Romantic Travellers through their paintings and travel journals, told of Amalfi and its Coast at the centre of European cultural life, leading to tourism slowly exploding... A visit to Amalfi cannot be without tasting the traditional dishes, the IG T Lemons of Amalfi and the "scialatielli pasta", the "cheese crepes" and the "lemon babas"... Do not miss walking along Via Maestra dei Villaggi, towards the Valle delle Ferriere or the Torre dello Ziro... or the narrow streets of the old town so as to go to: the ancient Arsenal, the monumental complex of the Cathedral, the Paper Museum as well as that of Peasant Life and the Museum of the Sea, the ancient cloisters of the Hotel Luna or Hotel Convento... As well as the folklore, which is particularly rich in events. They start with the Christmas celebrations, with the culmination being New Year's Eve and the loud parade of folk groups, firework displays and disco music in the square. This is followed by the Easter celebrations, with striking Good Friday procession and every four years, there is the "Historical Regatta of the Ancient Maritime Republics". Conclude the festivities: the naval procession of Saint Anthony of Padua, on June 13; the celebrations in honour of St. Andrew, patron saint of the city, on the 27 June, the feast of St. Mary Magdalene in Atrani with its spectacular firework displays over the sea on July 22.

365 DAYS OF EVENTS



There is an extensive calendar of festivities and events, with many not to be missed. **They start with the Christmas celebrations, particularly rich in events, which go from 8 December, the day of the Immaculate Conception to the Epiphany, with the highlight being the "falling star" at midnight on 24 December, and with the shows organized for New Year's Eve that, in Amalfi, is celebrated in the main square!**
For the Amalfitan Carnival, there are parades with masked dancers and small artisan floats, that are the result of the locals' imagination. This is followed by Lent, in preparation for Easter, the highest expression of Christianity as well as Amalfi tradition. The "Sacred Sepulchres", with the altars adorned with albino wheat, announce the beginning of **Holy Week in the Amalfi churches. The celebrations start with the Stations of the**

11 BEACHES AND A WONDERFUL COAST



The Marina of Atrani is the first beach that can be seen on the map and is inserted in one of the most suggestive scenarios of the Amalfi Coast, with the tiny houses of the village and the dome of the main church.

The promontory of San Francesco, upon which stands the tower of the same name, separates the beach from Amalfi and the **Marina Grande**. Wide and always very popular, it is the beach of the Amalfitani, but is also much appreciated by tourists. In the summer, there are lidos which, in addition to the beach and bar services, also have renowned restaurants.

Walking along the Lungomare dei Cavalieri there is: **La Marinella, the Spiaggia del Porto**, at the end of the port, the tiny **Spiaggia dei Protontini**, followed by the **Spiaggia delle Sirene**.

VIA MAESTRA DEI VILLAGGI

Following the ancient main way, visiting the villages of Pastena, Lone and Poggerola and their churches. Return to Amalfi following the Via Nuova staircase to Amalfi.

Time: 3.5 h Distance: about 7.00 Km | Diff: E, with + 600 - 450 | Indications: CAI 361 + 359

FROM AMALFI TO ATRANI

Crossing the eastern side of Amalfi, arriving in Atrani to discover its secrets and wonders.

Time: 2.5 h (including visits) | Distance: 1.5 Km approx. | Altitude: +/- 40 m | Difficulty: T | Indications: tourist directions

To go towards even clearer water and more suggestive natural scenery, it is possible to take advantage of the shuttle services that depart from Molo Pennello or, pass through Amalfi and continue along the State Highway 163 in the direction of Positano, to reach the beaches of **Duoglio** and the **two Spiagge di Santa Croce**.

Both beaches have lidos and a restaurant. Furthermore, the beach of Duoglio can be reached via a staircase of about 700 steps that starts from the state highway, at Km 24.8. Continuing along the coast, the next beach is the beautiful **Le Marinelle**, which cannot be seen from the ground due to the steep rock face that frames it. The Amalfi beaches end with the **Spiaggia della Vite**, which lies beyond the Vettica Minore promontory and the tower of the same name.
